Collier School Covid Reopening Summary September 2021

Due to the spike in COVID cases and using an abundance of caution, Collier School will continue with most of the protocols we put in place last year. We will continue to evaluate these protocols and the current trends throughout the school year and adjust accordingly.

- 1. Collier will continue to have a staggered bus arrival. Passengers and drivers on buses should be masked.
- Students will have their temperature checked getting off their bus and will be asked screening questions regarding Covid compatible symptoms, (we will maintain the three areas for student arrival) and will report directly to first period class.
- 3. Will continue masking procedures indoors and outdoors for both vaccinated and unvaccinated people.
- 4. During our school day, the following protocols will continue:
 - Attempt to maintain physical distancing of 3ft in classrooms whenever possible and feasible.
 - Continue use of barriers in classrooms, offices and lunch rooms.
 - Maintain our lunch cohorts as is and social distancing in lunch areas.
 - Bathroom usage will be limited in all buildings.
 - Continue Hand Hygiene and Respiratory Etiquette
 - Continue to limit shared supplies and equipment. Initial school supplies will be given to students on the first day of school.
 - Maintain our current protocols for symptomatic students and staff isolation area behind high school.
- 5. Clubs and activities that allow for social distancing will take place
- 6. Field Trips will be limited and will require prior administration approval.
- End of the day dismissal will continue to be staggered but will not start until 2:28pm.

- 8. Faculty rooms will be available for staff to use practicing social distancing.
- 9. Faculty meetings for the high school will be held in person in the gym practicing social distancing. Faculty meetings for the middle school will be held in person in MS APR practicing social distancing. Faculty meeting for the transition program will be held on Wednesday in the Solar building.
- 10. Write-up meetings for the HS will begin using a virtual platform.
- 11. As per the Department of Education, Collier is required to offer a remote learning option for students who must quarantine for positive COVID test results and/or direct exposures <u>only</u>. A virtual learning platform cannot be offered to students for any other reason.
- 12. Covid Communication Protocol (effort to streamline communication):
 - Any staff member that has a covid related situation should speak directly to Joyce.
 - Any staff member that hears of a covid related student issue, should speak directly to their building administrator as soon as possible (they should NOT call the nurse directly). The building administrator will then contact the appropriate school nurse.

 - High school/STAR program Tom
 - Transition Program Jeff
 - Kateri Program Judy
- 13. Vaccination records
 - Staff vaccine records should be sent directly to Joyce.
 - Student vaccine records should be sent to Theresa (HS, Kateri, Transition) or Anna (MS).
- 14. Currently, Collier Schools will follow CDC Travel Guidelines for vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals.
